

SMITH SCHOOL EXTRA CURRICULAR CONTRACT

Smith School encourages all students to participate in extra-curricular activities. The school body and the school community take great pride in providing programs in order to enhance and promote well-balanced, motivated students.

Being a member of a Smith School Team (including an extra-curricular group or club) is considered a privilege for our students. Many teachers run extra-curricular activities on their own time because they are passionate about bringing a wide variety of learning experiences to our students. It is expected that our students will observe the school Code of Conduct so that activities are enjoyable and safe for all involved.

The following is a brief reminder of what is expected of our students:

1. Team members will complete all assigned work in their classrooms to the best of their ability. If academic performance/attitude decreases and assignments are incomplete the participation in extra-curricular activities will be reviewed. It is expected that teachers will communicate between one another when a concern arises. Parents will be informed.
2. Appropriate conduct by team members is expected. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. This includes speaking disrespectfully about another teammate, coach or competitor or physical behaviour that is unsafe. Inappropriate conduct at anytime will result in a suspension of a practice, a game and/or tournament.
3. Appropriate conduct is also expected during the school day. If

behaviour is deemed unacceptable by any teacher or the principal, a team member will face suspension from a practice, a game and/or a tournament.

4. By choosing to participate in extra-curricular activities students will be expected to make a commitment that will require sacrifice of personal time. Students are expected to attend practices, games and meetings. It is expected that students will let staff know if they cannot attend a meeting, practice or game.

All students who elect to participate in extra-curricular activities are visible representatives of Smith School. Playing on a school team or joining a club will provide students with an environment where they can develop leadership skills, self-esteem, pride and teamwork. We encourage participation and look forward as a staff to this special time with our students.
